





Instructions


Step 1: To post a discussion in Canvas, navigate to your course.




Step 2: Click **Course Menu** on the left side of the page and then click **Discussions**.




Step 3: Click on the desired discussion link from the **Discussions** page.




Step 4: To create an introduction thread, click the **Start a Thread** button below the discussion instructions.

One classic example of a design disaster is the 1978 Ford Pinto. The car was infamously known design, beyond cost-cutting and aesthetic considerations.




