Instructions

Step 1: Once you are ready to submit an assignment in Canvas, locate your assignment in the **Apply** section of the module. Click on the **assignment title** to begin the submission process.



Step 5: Use the **Submission Portal** to submit your assignment. You can submit your assignment by dragging and dropping your file or clicking **Choose a file to upload**.




Step 6: Once you have uploaded your assignment, click the check box to agree to the Turnitin End-User License Agreement, which is located in the bottom left corner of the Submission Portal. *



*Note: You will not be able to submit the assignment until you click the End-User License Agreement check box.

Step 7: Click the Submit Assignment button, which is located in the bottom right corner of the Submission Portal.



Step 8: The submitted assignment file will appear in the document viewer. Ensure this is the correct file. *
