

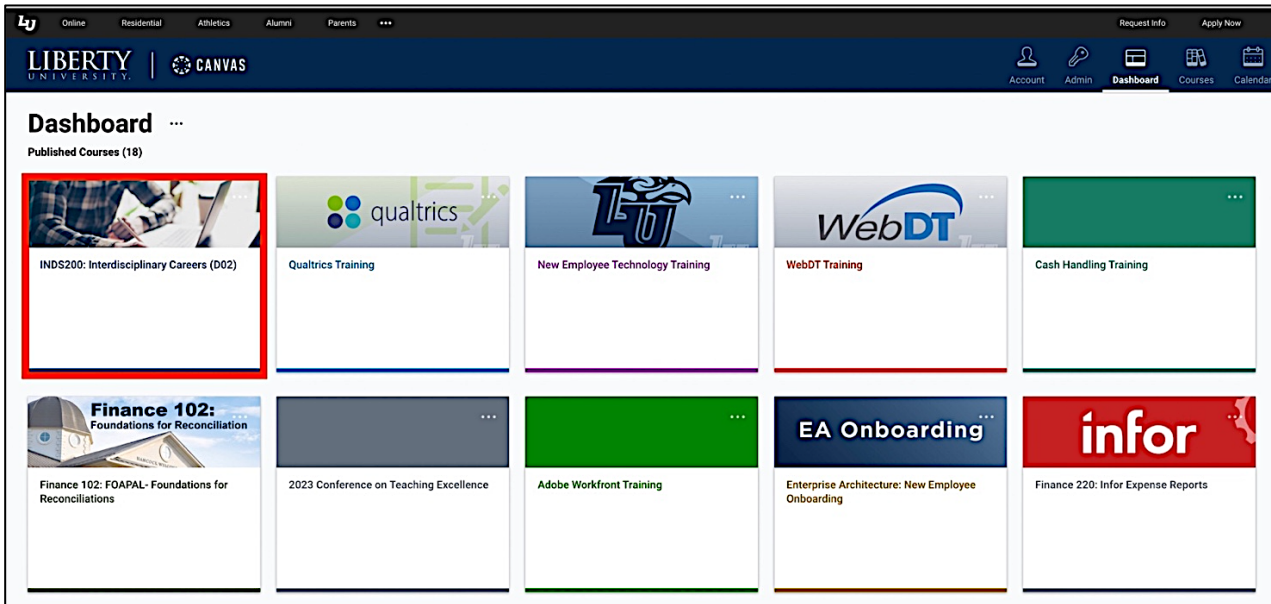

Introduction

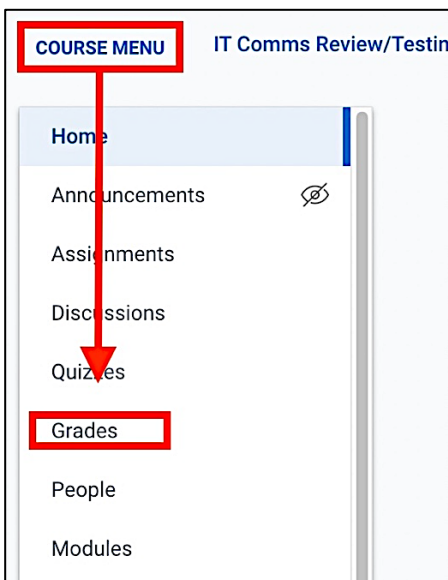
In Canvas, there are multiple ways to view assignment feedback. This training document will demonstrate the recommended method to easily view all feedback for graded assignments.



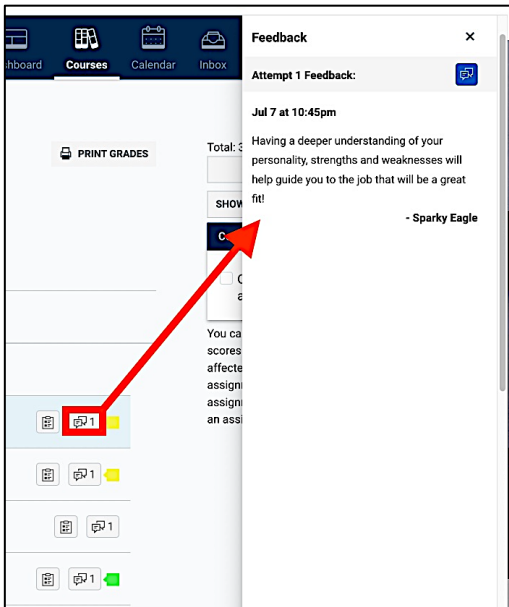
