- PROGRAM NOTES -

IT: Chapter 2 – Trailer (2019):

IT: Chapter 2 is the second part in a series of films based on the novel *IT* by Stephen King. A creature that feeds on fear (who often takes the form of a clown named Pennywise) terrorizes the town of Derry, Maine.

This trailer is a hybrid, beginning with a scene from the film before rapidly showing moments from the rest of the movie. During the opening scene, I was able to use several horror effects, as well as writing a piece for jazz trio to be played diegetically over a record player. The rest of the trailer is steeped in horror, as biting violins highlight the fear that our heroes find themselves against.

The Rings of Power – Sauron’s Resurrection:

The Rings of Power is a series created for Amazon Prime based on the Middle-earth universe of J.R.R. Tolkien and serve as a prequel to *The Hobbit* and *The Lord of the Rings*. In this scene, having been betrayed by the leader of the orcs, Adar, Sauron the Lord of Darkness, resurrects over the course of thousands of years.

Sauron’s form throughout most of this scene is comprised of all sorts of creepy-crawlies and insects, which prompted me to utilize a variety of dissonant 20th century orchestral effects. As he descends from the mountains, the orchestration becomes bare, like the cold, biting temperatures at high altitudes. However, as Sauron gains a new, human form, a melancholic cello sounds, signaling the return of an evil power.

Cosmos Laundromat:

Cosmos Laundromat is the 5th short film in the Blender Institute’s “open movie” project. The short follows a suicidal sheep named Franck who meets Victor, a strange salesman.

This short is absurdist, and constantly shifts tones, so I wished to embrace those elements in my music. With a Greco-acoustic feel throughout, we never dwell on any stable point for too long, even when an acoustic version of “Ride of the Valkyries” accompanies an inter-dimensional portal to who-knows-where. I wanted to make some music for the credits, which I originally did not have access to. As a result, the credits you will see are of a dubious origin...
