#### **BEFORE YOU ARRIVE:**

To adequately prepare for your time on campus, please complete the following steps:

- . **Check your email** if they haven't already, your professor will contact you with additional information on how to prepare for your time on campus. Be sure to log into your course(s) on Canvas and submit any required prework by the assigned deadline.
- . **Download the myLU app**, which includes a map to help you navigate our more than 7,000-acre campus.
- . Order your Flames Pass at least 2 weeks before you're due to arrive by visiting <code>Liberty.edu/FlamesPass</code> and clicking "Flames Pass." You can request to pick up your pass from ID & Campus Services when you arrive on campus or have it mailed to your home address.
- Pack comfortable shoes and check the weather for Lynchburg, Va., before you leave! Visit LUOnline.com/IntensiveDress for suggested classroom and casual attire.

### WHEN YOU ARRIVE:

Settle in before your class begins:

- . Once on campus, you can use the myLU app for directions.

## **DURING YOUR STAY**

#### CHECK-IN AND CHECKOUT

- · Your stay at Fairfield Inn & Suites includes a Sunday afternoon check-in and a Friday morning checkout. Payment for your stay is processed as part of Financial Check-In.
- . You will receive an email confirmation from the hotel prior to your visit.

#### DINING INFORMATION

- . Breakfast is provided at the hotel.
- Lunch is provided Monday—Friday on campus through LU Dining Services using the Flames Cash preloaded on your Flames Pass. Dining locations are within walking distance of your intensive location and can be found on the *myLU* app locate the drop-down menu in the upper left portion of the screen and select "Dining." You can add additional Flames Cash at Liberty.edu/FlamesCash.
- Prepacked dinners, distributed on Monday and Wednesday, can be stored in your hotel room refrigerator and reheated throughout the week. The dinner list will be provided to students at check-in on Sunday.

#### TRANSPORTATION

- Take advantage of our transit services to travel from your hotel to campus during your stay. Up-to-date information can be found on the myLU app — under the "All Navigation" drop-down menu, toggle "Transit Services."
- . Shuttles are available from the Lynchburg Regional Airport, Kemper Street Bus and Train Station, Richmond Airport, and the Roanoke Airport to campus for a fee. Shuttles must be reserved 48 hours in advance. To reserve your ride, visit *Liberty.edu/Transportation*.
