Complete 36 hours
 A maximum of 50% of the program hours may be transferred if approved and allowable, including credit from an earned degree from Liberty University on the same academic level
 3.0 GPA
 No grades lower than a B- may be applied to the degree
 Liberty University coursework that is more than 5 years old may not be applied towards this degree. Students are required to repeat the course if it has exceeded the age limit
 Degree must be completed within 5 years
 Submission of Degree Completion Application must be completed within the last semester of a student's anticipated graduation date

¹Students with RN license and bachelor's degree in a discipline other than Nursing must take NURS 226, 440, 446, 489 and 491 within the first year of the program.
²Introductory statistics course (math preferred) and an undergraduate course in health assessment (e.g. NURS 210) are required. For those who did not complete these courses in their undergraduate programs, they may fulfill these requirements during the first two semesters of the M.S.N. program. Students must complete the statistics course prior to enrollment in NURS 500
³NURS 631, 632, and 633 involve practicum hours (200 practicum hours). Students must obtain a preceptor site contract along with an MSN or doctorally prepared preceptor.
⁴Students must also complete all pre-practicum requirements prior to enrollment in any practicum course
