Frequently Asked Questions



Q: How much does the Residential Annex cost?

A: The Residential Annex is \$2,369 per semester.

Q: Is the Residential Annex considered on-campus or off-campus?

A: The Residential Annex is an on-campus living experience. This means that though it is not located on the main campus, all residents will be expected to uphold the On Campus Living Guide and the Liberty way.

Q: What is the address of the Residential Annex, and how far away is it from campus?

A: The Residential Annex is located at 3436 Odd Fellows Road, just a five-minute drive to main campus.

Q: I am a new student to Liberty University; can I live at the Residential Annex?

A: Yes, in limited cases new students are able to live at the Annex.

Q: What kind of parking pass will I have?

A: Residential Annex students will be eligible for commuter parking passes.

Q: Will there be transportation provided between Liberty University's main campus and the Residential Annex?

A: Yes. There will be transportation provided between main campus and the Residential Annex.

Q: What will hall leadership at the Residential Annex look like?

A: The Residential Annex will have the same leadership structure as all other residence halls on campus. Each hall will have two Resident Assistants, two Resident Shepherds, and multiple Community Group Leaders.

Q: What is the layout of the Residential Annex?

A: There are four residential buildings (A, B, C, and D). Buildings A and B are female, and C and D are male, with every room having a pedestrian door. There will be a large common room that all students will have access to, as well as a courtyard with a pool and volleyball court.

Q: What is the room layout, and what is provided in-room to residents?

A: Each room will house two students. There will be two beds, two dressers, two clothing racks, and two desks provided for student use.

Q: Will the Residential Annex have badge access or keys?

A: Residents will be provided with a key to access their particular room at move-in. All keys must be returned upon check-out.

Q: Can I still request a loft kit at the Residential Annex?

A: Yes! The same process for loft kit requests can be followed for residents of the Residential Annex.

Q: Where do I submit work orders or maintenance requests?

A: As with the rest of campus, students may submit both via SchoolDude. Select Zone 6 - Auxiliary Campus as your location, and Housing Annex 1 as the building.

Q: Will the pool be open at the Residential Annex?

A: Yes!

Q: Will there be laundry facilities on-site?

A: Yes!
