## LIBERTY UNIVERSITY HAZING MISCONDUCT REPORT

As of July 1, 2024

Pursuant to Adams's Law (VA. CODE § 23.1-822), Liberty University publicly reports findings of past hazing misconduct involving student organizations. Fortunately, most colleges that do not have social fraternities and sororities tend to have few, if any, hazing incidents. Even so, Adam's Law applies to all Virginia colleges and universities, including universities like Liberty that do not have Greek Life.

The information below includes the name of the student organization, the date(s) of the hazing incident (if known), the date the incident was reported to the University, the dates of investigation and when the student organization was found responsible, and a description of the findings. Reports of hazing that did not result in a finding of responsibility are not included. The University will update this information at least ten (10) calendar days prior to the start of each fall and spring semester, and will maintain the information for ten (10) years following the date of initial disclosure.
